#### Day 1 / Edinburgh

Meet upon arrival at the airport and transfer to your Hotel. Check into the Hotel. Rest of the day free at leisure. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 2 / Edinburgh

Breakfast at the Hotel. Hop On Hop Off Edinburgh Tour with 1 Day Ticket - Make your own way to the starting point of the tour which is Hanover Street. . Edinburgh has been the Capital of Scotland since the 15th Century and stands proudly on seven hills creating the dramatic skyline of this lively cosmopolitan city. What better way to see this fantastic city than from the top of an Edinburgh Tour Bus?. Compare Edinburgh's Old Town, where families lived in cramped conditions and rubbish was thrown out of the windows to the elegant Georgian New Town with its three main streets and a square at either end. Hear about the hangings that took place in the Grassmarket as you marvel at the impenetrable Castle Rock above you and hear about the attempts to capture Edinburgh Castle. See the Royal Mile which joins Edinburgh Castle to the Palace of Holyrood House. The tour will highlight all the things to do and see in Edinburgh as you tour through the city streets. #### Day 3 / Loch Ness, Highlands, Glencoe

Breakfast at the Hotel, This morning make your way to the starting point for the tour in central Edinburgh. Your Full Day Loch Ness, Highlands, Glencoe Tour is a very interesting tour. Get comfortable inside your top of the range mini-coach and depart to Loch Ness and the Scottish Highlands, stopping along the way to hear insightful commentary from your guide. Pass by Stirling Castle, the Wallace Monument, and Linlithgow Palace the birthplace of Mary Queen of Scots—en route to Glencoe, a Highland glen filled with eerie tales about the Clan MacDonald massacre of 1692. Journey onward through the 18th-century Fort William, and gaze out at the Scottish Highlands, including the Great Glen. Reaching Fort Augustus, disembark on the shores of Loch Ness, where you can opt for a seasonal boat ride on the loch and listen for the Loch Ness Monster 'Nessie' on the sonar system. Cruise is optional. Cruises run from Easter to the end of October.) After you purchase lunch (own expense), continue your drive to Cairngorms National Park via Spean Bridge village. Take in the views of Loch Laggan and the windswept mountains, including Craig Meagaidh, where the TV series 'Monarch of the Glen' was filmed. Your tour concludes with the return drive to Edinburgh. Overnight at the Hotel.

### Day 4 / St Andrews & the Fishing Villages of Fife

Breakfast at the Hotel. This morning you will proceed on the Full Day Tour St Andrews & the Fishing Villages of Fife. This small-group day trip to St. Andrews starts in central Edinburgh, where you're picked up in the personalised comfort of a top-of-the-range, 16-seat Mercedes mini-coach. Your guide narrates and makes plenty of stops, allowing for more intimate knowledge at each Scotland destination. Traversing the Forth Road Bridge over the Firth of Forth, you're treated to views of the Forth Rail Bridge, a cantilever railway bridge and UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enter the peninsular Kingdom of Fife, surrounded by the Firth of Tay and the North Sea, and listen to anecdotes about the photogenic coastal villages of East Neuk. Make a stop in the harbour-side town of Anstruther before descending upon St. Andrews, a mediaeval town and 1,000-year-old capital of the Scottish Church. You have free time to stroll around the University of St. Andrews attended by Prince William and the country's oldest university and see where golf is played at the Old Course. Use your complimentary discount card here at local restaurants, shopping, and attractions. On the return drive to Edinburgh, head to Falkland, a village dominated by the imposing Falkland Palace once belonging to Scotland's royal family. Cross the Lomond Hills and see where Mary Queen of Scots was imprisoned at Loch Leven. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 5 / Edinburgh

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the hotel by 1100 hrs. Day free at leisure on your own until departure transfer to the airport/train station.
