## Day 1 / Reykjavik

Meet upon arrival at the airport and transfer to your Hotel. Check into the Hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to explore Reykjavik. You can stroll the charming capital city, visit museums, and explore landmarks. Downtown Reykjavík offers numerous excellent restaurants, cafés, coffeehouses, and bars, for those who want to experience the renowned Reykjavík nightlife. Overnight at the Hotel.

### Day 2 / Reykjavik

Breakfast at the Hotel. This morning you proceed for a Half Day City Tour of Reykjavik. The tour begins at the old Höfði house where the historic summit between American president Ronald Reagan and Russian president Mikhail Gorbatsjov took place in 1986. Höfði house is also believed to be home to a ghost known as the White Lady. The tour continues to the stunning Harpa concert hall and conference centre which was the winner of the 2013 European Union Prize for Contemporary Architecture—the Mies van der Rohe Award. Next up is the city centre where we will see the infamous Hallgrímskirkja church, whose unique design was inspired by the basalt lava columns—a common volcanic rock formation in Icelandic nature. We proceed to the viewing platform at Perlan which provides a breathtaking 360° view over the charming city of Reykjavík.. The final stop on the tour is on the outskirts of the capital to visit Bessastaðir, the official residence of the President of Iceland. Make your own way back to your hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 3 / Reykjavik - Golden Circle Tour - Reykjavik

Breakfast at the Hotel. #### Day 4 / South Iceland, Waterfalls and Black Sand Beach Tour

On this tour of South Iceland, you will also experience the powerful beauty of Seljalandsfoss waterfall, where the Seljalandsá river, which originates under Eyjafjallajökull glacier, falls, as well as Skógafoss, one of the largest waterfalls in Iceland. Just outside the town of Vík í Mýrdal (or just Vík to the locals), you will visit the soaring basalt rock formation known as Reynisdrangar and the black sand beach of Reynisfjara.
