Day 1 / Reykjavik

Meet upon arrival at the airport and transfer to your Hotel. Check into the Hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to explore Reykjavik. You can stroll the charming capital city, visit museums, and explore landmarks. Downtown Reykjavík offers numerous excellent restaurants, cafés, coffeehouses, and bars, for those who want to experience the renowned Reykjavík nightlife. Day free at leisure. Overnight at the Hotel

Day 2 / Reykjavik

Breakfast at the Hotel. Proceed for a Full Day Reykjavik Hop on Hop Off + The Golden Circle Tour. There's no easier way to explore the world's northernmost capital than on a Hop-On Hop-Off Bus Tour. Let us take you to all of Reykjavik's must-see landmarks and you'll discover everything from the towering Hallgrímskirkja Church and the iconic Harpa Concert Hall with its colourful glass façade, to the largest whale exhibition in Europe. Plus, why not take some time out from your city tour and relax in the Laugardalur geothermal pool or stroll around the beautiful Botanical Garden? But it doesn't end there... Leave the city far behind and venture south of Reykjavik where you'll explore the breathtaking Golden Circle on a day tour and see the geology that makes this landscape so unique. Visit the UNESCO World Heritage Site, Thingvellir National Park, with its immense rift valley where the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates meet, be amazed by the sheer scale of the two-tiered Gullfoss Waterfall and see the active Strokkur geyser erupt, spouting water around 20 metres into the air in the Geysir Geothermal Area. You'll also step inside the Friðheimar Greenhouse and learn how geothermal energy is used to cultivate pesticide-free tomatoes! Overnight at the Hotel



Day 3 / South Iceland, Waterfalls and Black Sand Beach Tour

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today we will proceed on a Full Day Tour of South Iceland, Waterfalls and Black Sand Beach Tour. From pitch-black volcanic sand beaches to snow-capped peaks of Iceland's biggest volcanoes, South Iceland is a visually spectacular and geologically intriguing part of the country that features many of Iceland's most awe-inspiring destinations. Your South Iceland journey will take you through the country's lush farmlands, flanked by rugged mountains, glaciers (including the infamous Eyjafjallajökull) and volcanoes of the interior on one side and vast Atlantic ocean views on the other. On this tour of South Iceland, you will also experience the powerful beauty of Seljalandsfoss waterfall, where the Seljalandsá river, which originates under Eyjafjallajökull glacier, falls, as well as Skógafoss, one of the largest waterfalls in Iceland. Just outside the town of Vík í Mýrdal (or just Vík to the locals), you will visit the soaring basalt rock formation known as Reynisdrangar and the black sand beach of Reynisfjara. A written description is nothing compared to the lived experience. Let the guides bring South Iceland to life with stories, facts, science, and history. Overnight at the Hotel

Day 4 / Reykjavik - Snæfellsnes Peninsula Tour - Reykjavik

Breakfast at the Hotel. We will embark on the Full Day Tour of Snæfellsnes Peninsula Tour. This tour takes you west from Reykjavik on a scenic route to Borgarfjörður and the village of Borgarnes where a short stop will be made for refreshments. Shortly after entering Snæfellsnes peninsula, by Ytri-Tunga Farm you'll get a chance to spot local wildlife at the beach which is home to a seal colony and variety of seabirds. Next up is a visit to the idyllic Arnarstapi village where you'll take a walk to view the extraordinary landscape along the precipitous shoreline and where a break will be made for lunch. After lunch, the tour continues to Djúpalónssandur, a tranquil, black-pebbled beach that offers beautiful views out to the sea and fascinating history that lies in the Snæfellsjökull National Park, close to where Jules Verne located his entrance for the "Journey to the Centre of the Earth". Leaving Djúpalónssandur you'll travel past striking landscapes to the north coast of Snæfellsnes peninsula to Grundarfjörður fishing village. Surrounded by exceptionally beautiful mountains Grundarfjörður is home to one of the peninsula's most iconic and photographed landmarks, the symmetrical mountain Kirkjufell that towers 1500 ft. up from the shoreline. Out of Grundarfjörður, the route lies across Berserkjahraun lava fields that according to Viking legends was where two Swedish "Berserks" forged Iceland's first road and over to the south side of the peninsula through Vatnaleið pass. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 5 / South Coast & Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon Tour

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today we will proceed on a South Coast & Jökursárlón Glacier Lagoon Tour. You will travel along Iceland's South Coast on the narrow strip of lush farmland that cuts between mountains, glaciers, and the vast Atlantic Ocean. The journey includes stops at natural treasures, including the iconic Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss waterfalls, views of Skaftafell National Park, Diamond Beach, and Vatnajökull glacier to name but a few. Passing the southern edge of the mighty Vatnajökull Glacier roughly midway between Reykjavik and Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon offers magnificent views of glaciers, rivers and endless plains of sand. Vatnajökull Glacier National Park stretches over an area of 14,000 square km, or roughly ten times the size of London. Packed with icebergs in various shades of white and blue, the extraordinary scenery at Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon is sure to take your breath away. Numerous bird species can be seen feeding in and around the lagoon, and seals are a fairly common sight both at the mouth of the lagoon and at the seaside beach. Later we will return to our hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 6 / Reykjavik

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the hotel by 1100 hrs. Day free at leisure on your own until departure transfer to the airport/train station.
