Day 1 / Tangier

Meet and greet upon arrival and transfer to your hotel. Check in at the hotel. Rest of the day free to explore Tangier on your own. Overnight at the Hotel

Day 2 / Tangier - Fez

Breakfast at the Hotel. You will have a hotel pick up. Discover fascinating history and vibrant culture on a 4-hour sightseeing tour of Tangier, and take in the iconic sights of an ancient city. Explore the Hercules Caves beneath Spartel Cape, whose lighthouse guides ships through the treacherous Straights of Gibraltar. Trace the narrow lanes of Tangier's old medina, an atmospheric labyrinth of craftsman's shops that runs along the bustling port. Visit the storied Grand Socco, and walk in the footsteps of its former residents; Matisse, Paul Bowles and William Burroughs lived and worked in this atmospheric seaside city. In the afternoon you will be transferred to Tangier train station where you will connect your train to Fez. (Standard Train Travel Included). Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Check in Hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

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Day 3 / Full-Day Meknes and Volubilis Tour

Breakfast at the Hotel. You will be picked up from your hotel for the Guided Full-Day Meknes and Volubilis Tour. Your guide will take you through Volubilis, Moulay Idriss, Mekens excursion with its outstanding monuments. The first destination of the day will be Volubilis, which is a roman ancient city, established near Meknes in a rich agricultural area. It is also well known for being a UNESCO World Heritage Site, because of its remaining buildings of the protected city, covering more than 40 Hectares. Our guide will explain to you every bit of this site's outstanding history, that will amaze you even more. You can take a picture to remember the moment. Later we return to your hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 4 / Fez - Rabat

Breakfast at the Hotel. Half Day Guided Tour of Fez. You will be picked up from your hotel in the morning. See the best of Fez with this comprehensive guided tour. Explore the twisting streets of the old Medina, with shops selling spices, carpets, silver, and more. See a university dating back to AD 859, the elegant Nejjarine Fountain, the pungent Chouara Tannery, and the blue-tiled Bab Boujloud. Visit the former Jewish Quarter, the gates of the Royal Palace, and an Andalusian-style garden before returning to your hotel. Lose yourself in the charm of the Fez Medina, a UNESCO World Heritage Site Visit fountains, Andalusian gardens, and architectural gems. In the afternoon return to your hotel. Departure transfer to Fez Train Station. Connect your train to Rabat (Standard Class train ticket Included). Meet upon arrival at Rabat Train Station and transfer to your hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 5 / Rabat - Marrakech

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today morning we will proceed for a Half Day Guided City Tour of Rabat. Discover the main sights in Rabat. Hassan Tower, the minaret of an incomplete mosque, and the Mausoleum of Mohammed V and his two sons,late King Hassan II and Prince Abdallah. The building is considered a masterpiece of modern Alaouite dynasty architecture. Next, visit the 12th-century Kasbah of the Udayas named Al Mahdia in reference to the original leader Al Mahdi Ben Tumurt. Originally this Kasbah was a Ribat (a military defence) but in 2012, it was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Then, explore the ancient ramparts and shops in the old medina. Later you will be transferred back to your hotel. Later you will proceed to Rabat train station. Connect your train to Marrakesh (Standard Class Ticket Included). Arrive in Marrakesh and you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 6 / Marrakesh

Breakfast at the Hotel . Today we will enjoy a 13 hour Full Day Ouarzazate Tour. Enjoy a fabulous journey through the Atlas mountains to the desert's door & through the valleys, beautiful Kasba & Game of Thrones filming location Journey through the breathtaking countryside via TiziN'Tichka pass (7,415ft), the highest pass in North Africa. Discover a remarkable area characterised by the magnificence and beauty of its various landscapes. We will stop for a visit to the famous, fortified city of Ait Ben Haddou Kasbah. Classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, it has been the backdrop for many films. After lunch, we will enjoy a city tour of Ouarzazate, whose name is the Berber word for "no noise.", then visit the Taourirt and Tifoultoute Kasbahs which were the ancient residences of Glaoui (Old Pacha of Marrakech). Afterwards, we return to Marrakech. Overnight at the Hotel.

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Day 7 / Marrakech - Casablanca

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today morning you will be picked up from your hotel for your Half Day Marrakech Tour. We have created this as the most comprehensive tour in Marrakech, for travellers who want to get the most of what the Red City has to offer. Dive into the rich history of Morocco's most exciting & mysterious imperial city, and immerse yourself into its souks, where merchants have been selling their goods for 1000+ years! Day 8 / Casablanca

Breakfast at the Hotel. You will be picked up from your hotel for your Half Day Guided City Tour Casablanca. Largest city and economic capital of Morocco, Casablanca has an incredible architectural heritage! The tour will take you to visit Casablanca and its most emblematic places! a nice half day to discover the best sites of the majestic city begin with the Fabulous Hassan II Mosque.Let's go through the place Mohammed V and the old medina, the Habous district without forgetting the elegant church Notre Dame and the many other sites. Hassan II Mosque Hassan II Mosque is a mosque located in Casablanca. Erected partly on the sea, it is a religious and cultural complex, built on nine hectares. Far from the noisy and busy streets of the ancient Medinas, the Habous have a peaceful and calm atmosphere, an atmosphere full of spirituality. It comes of course from the beautiful mosque "Mohammadi", and the many tiny offices of the adouls around it. A little further, the street of booksellers with its beautiful arcades and its many windows, offers to see beautiful bound books, precious illuminations and examples of calligraphy sought. Behind begins the street Ibn Khaldoun. There is a real open-air theatre, with all the jewellery sellers, djellabas and other slippers. There are beautiful pieces of traditional Moroccan crafts. shops with their colourful objects piled up on the ground look like real caves of Ali Baba. IIn this real labyrinth that is the medina, rich of its various souks with spices, olives, and its kissarias, visitors forget the fury of the city. Passage of this beautiful district: the pastry Bennis, specialist of Moroccan pastry since 1930, which is nestled in an unnamed house and whose Moroccan cakes, horns of gazelle, briouates and other chhiwates are famous throughout the country. he tour will end at midday and you are free to explore Casablanca on your own. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 9 / Casablanca

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the hotel by 1100 hrs. Day free at leisure on your own until departure transfer to the airport/train station.

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
