Day 1 / Helsinki

Meet and greet upon arrival at Helsinki Airport and transfer to your hotel. Check into the Hotel by 1400hrs. Rest of the day free at leisure. Overnight

Day 2 / Helsinki

Breakfast at the Hotel. In the morning, proceed for Helsinki by Hop on Hop Off Bus. Sitting on the Gulf of Finland, Helsinki balances colourful history with a laid-back pace and modern, edgy vibe. The city's architecture recalls the era of Russian and Swedish rule, and its maritime heritage gives its history a fascinating extra edge. So climb aboard your open-top, double-decker bus to discover the many landmarks and contrasts of this surprising and exciting city. See top Helsinki attractions such as Senate Square – the huge, open square that's home to Helsinki Cathedral – and the spectacular Temppeliaukio Church, known as the Rock Church; an underground, 1960s-built church carved from solid rock. Pass the

restored Lasipalatsi building, a masterpiece of modernist architecture from the 1930s, and if you wish, or leave the bus to experience the Market Square, Helsinki's most international and famous market. Armed with your ticket, you can choose to stay aboard for the complete, approximately 1.5-hour loop to see all the sights on route and listen to the engaging audio commentary in full. Alternatively, create your own sightseeing itinerary as you go: hop on and off at any of the 18 stops to explore the attractions on foot. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 3 / Helsinki - Tallinn (Estonia)

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today you will proceed to Tallin in Estonia by ferry(Ferry Ticket Included) Departure transfer to ferry terminal where you will take the ferry which will take 2 hrs. Arrive in Talling and meet your driver who will transfer you to your hotel. Check in 1400hrs. The rest of the day is at leisure for you to explore the city on your own in the city near your hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 4 / Tallinn - Stockholm

Breakfast at the Hotel. Proceed for Hop on Hop off Tour of Tallinn. Explore Tallinn on an action-packed hop-on, hop-off bus tour. The strategic routes and stops of the bus tour cover all the major Tallinn attractions. On this hop-on, hop-off tour, you are free to create your own sightseeing itinerary. You can hop on at any of Tallinn's stops and hop off whenever you want to visit one of the attractions. Your ticket is valid for 24 hours. Some of the attractions that are covered - Open Air Museum, Rocca al Mare Shopping Centre. Zoo, Maarjamäe Castle, Seaplane Harbour Museum, Botanic Garden. Old town. Pirita Beach. Toompea Hill and Song Festival Grounds. At 1630 hrs you will depart to the Ferry Terminal to board your overnight ferry to Stockholm. Your ferry will depart at 1815 hrs and you have a Double Room as an Outside Cabin. Overnight onboard the Ferry. (Ferry Included)

Day 5 / Stockholm

Breakfast on board Cruise. Ferry arrives at 1015 hrs. Meet and transfer to your hotel. Check in Hotel. Rest of the day free at leisure to explore Stockholm on your own. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 6 / Stockholm

In the morning proceed for your 24 hours Stockholm Hop on Hop Off Bus Tour. Board your distinctive red double-decker bus closest to you and commence your tour of Scandinavia's most stylish city. With your ticket, you can remain on the bus for the entire loop or disembark whenever a monument or museum demands your attention. Cruise the sophisticated streets and listen to informative audio commentary that details the Viking past and prosperous present of the capital. Scan the skyline for magnificent monuments like Gamla Stan (the atmospheric Old Town), the majestic Royal Palace, and the perfectly preserved Viking ship within the Vasa Museum. Disembark at Kulturhuset to immerse yourself in interesting exhibitions and sample some regional delicacies in a rustic local restaurant. Enjoy this interesting tour. In the evening return to your hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 7 / Stockholm - Copenhagen

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today morning you will check out of your hotel and have a departure transfer to the train station to connect to a 5 hour train journey to reach the lovely city of Copenhagen, the capital of Denmark (Standard Train Travel Included). Before your train arrives do not miss the famous Öresund bridge connecting Sweden with Denmark. Copenhagen got its name from the word "köbenhavn", which means "Merchants Harbour". It is a captivating, friendly City where there is always something wonderful around the corner to see, smell, taste, feel and listen to. Meet upon arrival and transfer to your Hotel. Check in Hotel. Rest of the afternoon free to explore Copenhagen. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 8 / Copenhagen - Cruise to Oslo

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the Hotel and leave your baggage at reception. Then Explore the day with the 24 hours Copenhagen Hop on Hop Off Bus Tour. Step onboard your open-top, double-decker bus from the two available—either the Classic Tour or the All Lines Tour with its three routes around Copenhagen. Then, when you're in Denmark's capital, simply hop aboard and set off to explore the sights. Relax into your comfortable seat and listen to the entertaining onboard audio commentary as you travel around your chosen tour route. On the Classic Tour, choose to stay aboard for the entire loop, and drink in the 360-degree views of landmarks such as the Little Mermaid, the harbour statue inspired by the Hans Christian Andersen fairytale. Or explore top Copenhagen attractions including the Amalienborg Palace, the winter home of the Danish royal family. On the All Lines Tour (May to September only), admire the views along the three included city routes the Classic Tour route together with the Colourful Copenhagen Tour route and the Urban Green Tour route. Take snaps of the passing sights, such as the beautiful Little Mermaid statue and the Amalienborg Palace, and hop off at any of the stops along the three routes to discover the attractions on foot. Perhaps leave the bus at the Tivoli Gardens to spend time at this world famous amusement park or step off at the freetown of Christiania, a commune in the middle of the city. Or maybe hop off at one of Copenhagen's prettiest buildings: Our Saviors Church, famous for its decorative helix spire with its winding staircase. These are just some of the things you can see and do on your hop-on hop-off tour. In the late afternoon departure transfer to Copenhagen Port to connect your overnight cruise to Oslo. At 1600hrs board the Cruise for Oslo for a wonderful ride on the North Sea and a night long party. Overnight on Cruise.

Day 9 / Cruise - Oslo

Breakfast on board Cruise. Arrive in Oslo by 0930hrs. You will be met upon arrival and transferred to your Hotel. Check into the Hotel. Leave baggage at Hotel Reception and proceed for a 24 hours Oslo Hop on Hop Off Bus Tour. Step onboard your open-top,double-decker bus at any of the stops in Oslo, and relax as you travel around the city, while listening to the audio commentary. Hop off and on again as many times as you like within 24 hours, and explore the city on your own terms. Why not disembark to visit the foreboding Akershus Fortress? Or hop off for a dose of Viking culture and history at Oslo's Viking Ship Museum. Other must-see attractions that are on your route include Vigeland Sculpture Park, Kon-Tiki Museum, and Royal Palace. Entrance fees are at your own expense. If you wish, stay on board for a full loop and enjoy sightseeing from your open-top, double-decker bus. Enjoy this interesting tour. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 10 / Oslo

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the hotel by 1100 hrs. Day free at leisure on your own until departure transfer to the airport/train station.
