# Day 1 / Paris

Meet and greet upon arrival and transfer to the Hotel. Check into the Hotel. Rest of the day is free for you to discover Paris on your own, maybe visit the museums or Eiffel Tower or many other important sights in Paris. Overnight at the Hotel.

## Day 2 / Paris (Hop on Hop Off with Eiffel Tower Level 2 and Cruise on Seine)

Breakfast at the Hotel. Explore your One day Hop-On Hop-Off bus ticket. Our first stop will be Eiffel Tower where we have to skip the line ticket to the 2nd floor. (Entrance Included). Then our next stop will be Champs-Elysees - The most beautiful avenue full with many shops and Arc de Triomphe. Next pass through the Musee d'Orsay- You can see the paintings of impressionist artists. Then next stop Arc de Triomphe. Arc de Triomphe is a monument commissioned by Napoleon for his glorious army when he returned covered in glory from the Austerlitz Battle. If you wish you can next visit Louvre Museum - Louvre is the house of Mona Lisa. (Admission not included). Next is Cathedrale Notre-Dame de Paris - The amazing and splendid gothic cathedral in Paris. Next see Palais Garnier - Great Opera House. Then enjoy a One Hour Cruise on the Seine. (seine river cruise ride included). Next stop is Le Trocadero et son esplanade Trocadero is a palace built for the world's fair. The buildings now house a number of museums: the Musée national de la Marine (naval museum) and the Musée de l'Homme (ethnology) in the southern (Passy) wing, the Cité de l'Architecture et du Patrimoine, including the Musée national des Monuments Français, in the eastern (Paris) wing, from which one also enters the Théâtre national de Chaillot, a theatre below the esplanade. (Admission for Museums not included). Next stop will be Conciergerie - It is an old prison where the last king Louis XVI and Marie Antoinnette were held before the execution. (Admission not included). Your last stop is Pont des Arts - Bridge with love padlocks (Admission Ticket Included). There are many other stops you can visit on your hop on hop off tour. After spending time visiting different parts of the city, take a break from the busy streets and relax on a leisurely cruise along the Seine. With cruises running at all hours of the day, you can experience the cruise under the midday sun, catching the sites as the sun disappears over the horizon or wait until after dark to see the monuments twinkling against the night sky. Regardless of the hour, it is sure to be an experience to remember. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 3 / Paris - Geneva

Breakfast at the Hotel. Transfer to the Train Station to connect with your TGV train to Geneva. (Standard Class Train Ticket Included). Arrive in Geneva and you will be transferred to your hotel. Check in at Hotel 1400hrs. Rest of the day free to explore Geneva on your own. Overnight at the Hotel.

# Day 4 / Geneva - Zermatt

Breakfast at the Hotel. You will make your own way to Geneva Bus Station (Place Dorcière) for your Geneva City Tour (SIC Basis) which will start at 1030 hrs. The City tour of Geneva will bring you to visit the International part of Geneva through the centre of the world's peacemaking organisations followed by a tour of the main tourist attractions of the City like the Fountain and the wonderful Flower Clock. Then get a taste of Geneva's history with the mini-train Tramway Tour and dig even deeper into the Old Town with your guide on a Walking tour. The tour will take around 3 hours. Then in the afternoon you will be transferred to the train station. Connect with your train to Zermatt (Standard Class Ticket Included). Arrive in Zermatt and you will be transferred to your hotel. Check in Hotel. Rest of the day is free to explore this vehicle free city. Overnight at the Hotel

### Day 5 / Zermatt - St.Moritz (Glacier Express)

Breakfast at the Hotel. Departure transfer to train station. Travel in the panoramic carriages of the Glacier Express from Zermatt to St. Moritz. During the journey you will drive over the Oberalp Pass, the Rhine Gorge - the "Grand Canyon of Switzerland", the Albula Line. The trip will take around 8 hours. Arrive in St. Moritz and you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today you are free to explore St. Mortiz on your own. Overnight at the Hotel

#### Day 7 / St.Moritz - Zurich

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the Hotel and you will be transferred to StMoritz train station to connect your train to Zurich. (Standard Class Ticket Included). Arrive and you will be transferred to your hotel. Check into the Hotel or if the room is not ready please leave baggage at reception. Make your way to the starting point of the tour at the centrally located Sihlquai Bus Terminal in Zurich. Explore Zurich City Tour. Cruise on your coach past popular attractions like the sophisticated shopping district of Bahnhofstrasse, a place considered one of the world's best shopping areas, and the architecturally rich university district. Admire from the outside the Church of Our Lady (Fraumunster); enjoy the pretty buildings of Limmatquai; and admire the exterior of some of the world's finest museums. Capture photographs of the charming Old Town as you travel towards opulent hillside villas backed by the sky-piercing summits of the Alpine mountains. Enjoy a moment of tranquillity beside the glittering Lake Zurich and then return to your original departure point, where the tour concludes. Overnight at the Hotel

#### Day 8 / Zurich - Innsbruck

Breakfast at the Hotel. You will have to transfer to the train station to connect your train to Innsbruck. (Standard Train Travel Included). Meet upon arrival in Innsbruck Train Station and transfer to your Hotel. Check into the Hotel by 1400hrs. Rest of the day is free at leisure. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 9 / Innsbruck - Salzburg

Breakfast at the Hotel. Proceed on 1 Day Hop on Hop Off Innsbruck Tour. Enjoy being chauffeured to the main sights and attractions! The Sightseer is a hop-on hop-off bus that gives you a great feel for your holiday destination. The bus also takes you to stops outside of the city centre so you save yourself a walk. The route passes, for example, the Bergisel Ski Jump and the Tirol Panorama Museum with its famous Giant Panoramic Painting, as well as Ambras Castle. The Sightseer also goes through the district of Pradl and past the lovely Gründerzeit villas in Saggen. The journey also takes you past the River Inn and the Imperial Gardens, as well as to the most important museums in and around the city centre. You can simply get off wherever you fancy and explore the surrounding area on foot before catching the next bus. An audio guide in eight languages provides information and stories about the sights and attractions you pass along the way. The ticket is also valid for IVB buses and trams in the centre of Innsbruck. Later in the late afternoon you will be transferred to the train station to connect your train to Salzburg. (Standard Train Travel Included). Arrive in Salzburg and you will be transferred to your hotel. Check in Hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 10 / Salzburg - Vienna

Breakfast at the Hotel. In the morning you will go on a The Original Sound of Music Tour.(SIC Basis). You will have to make your own way to the starting point of this tour at Mirabellplatz, directly in front of St. Andrä Church. Your guide will not only take you to the original locations of the film, where you will receive interesting information about the filming of The Sound of Music, but also offers you the opportunity to get to know the historic city of Salzburg and the enchanting landscape

of the Salzkammergut better learn. The tour is conducted in English. Relive your favourite scenes from the classic musical "The Sound of Music" on this Salzburg sightseeing tour. Visit filming sites around the city while your guide provides historical background on Salzburg's top attractions and architectural jewels, including the gazebo where "Sixteen Going on Seventeen" was shot. "The Sound of Music" filming locations tour in Salzburg See the beautiful locations where scenes from the movie were filmed Listen to the soundtrack and sing along to famous songs All transportation included. Later, return to your Hotel on your own. In the afternoon departure transfer to the train station to connect your train to Vienna (Standard Train Travel Included). Arrive in Vienna and transfer to your Hotel. Check into the Hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

### Day 11 / Vienna

Breakfast at the Hotel. In the morning proceed for City Tour & Schonbrunn sightseeing tour which starts at the Operngasse 8 and takes you to the Ringstrasse boulevard, where you pass many popular tourist attractions. First take a look at the impressive Vienna State Opera. It is home of the famous "Opera Ball" which takes place every year. Not far from the Opera, the grand Hofburg Palace is located, the former winter residence of the imperial family. Next you will see the monumental buildings of the Museum of Art History and the Museum of Natural History. Further sights on our tour are the neoclassical Parliament, the acclaimed Burgtheater and the striking City Hall. Later we will proceed for a Guided tour of Schloss Schönbrunn. On arrival at Schönbrunn Palace our guided tour starts at once, no need to wait for Austria's most popular tourist attraction! The former imperial summer residence is a listed World Heritage Site and attracts millions of people from all over the world every year. We visit the historic state-rooms and see how the imperial family once lived. You will also have time to take a stroll through the palace gardens or enjoy a cup of original Viennese coffee and a piece of delicious apple strudel. Our city tour ends at the Vienna State Opera. Later return to your Hotel. In the afternoon, you are free to explore Vienna on your own. Overnight at the Hotel

### Day 12 / Vienna

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the hotel by 1100 hrs. Day free at leisure on your own until departure transfer to the airport/train station.
