Day 1 / Rome

Meet and greet upon arrival and proceed directly to your Hotel Check in Hotel. Rest of the day free at leisure to explore Rome attractions on your own. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 2 / Rome

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today we will enjoy a Full Day Hop on Hop Off Rome. Rome has a bounty of things to see and the mix of its architecture is testament to its past; Roman ruins, baroque squares and Renaissance gardens combine to give the city its enticing edge. See it all on a Rome hop-on hop-off bus tour, and learn about the Italian capital as you go. Show your ticket





as you board your Rome tour bus, and then hop on and off at any of the eight stops around town. See the Colosseum where gory gladiatorial battles once took place, and have your camera ready for Piazza Venezia, home to the Vittorio Emanuele II Monument. Throw a coin into the Trevi Fountain for luck, or stretch your legs on a walk through Vatican City. The full loop lasts between 1.5 and 2 hours, and audio commentary is provided for each sight you pass. Make use on the free onboard Wi-Fi to share pictures, tweet or blog about your travels as you go. We can offer Skip-the-Line Tickets to Palatine Hill, the Roman Forum and Colosseum: Upgrade to include fast-track admission to three of Rome's top attractions (Check with our reservations team). Explore Rome's countless delights. Overnight at the Hotel

Day 3 / Rome - Florence - Pisa - Florence

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the Hotel. Morning transfer to the train station to connect the train to Florence (Standard Train Travel Included). Arrive and transfer to your Hotel. Check into the Hotel. Proceed to the starting point for your 1400hrs start of the Half Day Excursion to Pisa. A splendid excursion through the fertile and picturesque Tuscan countryside to the historic university city of Pisa, famous for its architectural beauty. Upon arrival in Pisa, your informative guide will take you on a thorough outdoor guided walking tour of Piazza dei Miracoli and its monuments (exterior). You will be dazzled by this marvellous square which is dominated by the Cathedral (interior), a model of the distinctive Pisan Romanesque architecture, the celebrated Leaning Tower of Pisa and the round-shaped Baptistery surrounded by its suggestive columned arcades. The commentary of our guide will be particularly focused on the Leaning Tower, one of the world. You will be enthralled by the history and the leaning structure of the Tower which stirs the imagination of all visitors. After the guided visit you will have some free time for memorable pictures or to discover on your own the historical quarter where you can admire the Church of San Sisto, one of the oldest churches in Pisa and Piazza dei Cavalieri, which was the political centre in the middle age and where the Scuola Normale is located, one of the most famous universities in the world. Return to Florence by evening. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 4 / Florence - Venice

Breakfast at the Hotel. Meet your guide in Central Florence. Walking Tour of Florence. From masterpieces of Renaissance art to royal Medici intrigue, Florence is like a living history museum waiting to be explored. Uncover its mediaeval secrets on this guided 2-hour walking tour of historic highlights including the Pitti Palace, Ponte Vecchio, Church of Santa Croce, Piazza della Repubblica and the iconic Duomo. Hear your guide's live narration clearly through an audio headset, and stop at one of the city's best 'gelaterias' for a scoop of ice cream. Explore the local streets on a walking tour of the city Family friendly Informative, friendly and professional guide. Later in the afternoon at around 1400 hrs departure transfer to Florence Railway Station to connect your train to Venice St Lucia Station.(Standard Train Travel Included). Arrive in Venice and you will be transferred to your Hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 5 / Venice

Breakfast at the Hotel. Meet your guide near St Mark's Square for your Walking Tour of Venice with Gondola Ride. This walking tour of Venice provides an excellent introduction to the city's highlights and history, plus the classic Venetian experience of riding in a gondola. Wander through the surrounding neighbourhood as your guide illuminates the history of Venice as a maritime superpower and incubator of Renaissance art. Admire iconic Venetian landmarks such as the Teatro la Fenice opera house, the Rialto Bridge and the mysterious spiral staircase of Scala del Bovolo. The specific tour itinerary may vary by day, as there is so much to see! After exploring the city's romantic streets by foot, climb aboard a traditional gondola boat for a romantic ride along the city's famous canals. Navigated by a friendly gondolier, cruise by spectacular historic structures along the Grand Canal and float down smaller watery ways in the Fenice neighbourhood. Then, step back on solid ground at the Dogana/Vallaresso Station in central Venice. Please note: The walking tour does not include entry to the monuments. End of tour. You have some time to explore Venice on your own in Venice. Your next tour will depart at 1400





hrs. In the afternoon you will proceed for a Visit to Torcello, Murano, and Burano—three islands in the Venetian Lagoon with your guide. This is a great way to see more than just the central sights of Venice and enjoy a cruise on the water. Your tour from Venice to Murano, Torcello, and Burano begins as you board your motorboat and set off across the Venetian Lagoon to your first stop, the island of Murano, which is actually several small isles dissected by a wide canal. Disembark the boat to walk aroundMurano with your guide. Visit a glass factory, where you watch a glassblower creating beautiful pieces of glassware, a Murano tradition that dates back to 1291. Hear a bit about the island's history from your guide, who tells you about Murano's prosperity in the 1400s and 1500s, when it was the centre of glassmaking in Europe. Then go admire other sights like churches decorated with mosaics and other ornamental details. Next, visit Torcello, an island established between the 5th and 6th centuries, to see its ornate palaces and churches. Highlights include the Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta, founded in the 7th century, and the excavated remnants of the baptistery in the Church of Santa Fosca. Then head to your third stop, Burano, an island known for its lace production, which dates back to the 16th century and was once the best in Europe. While you visit local shops and a museum to admire high-end lace on display, admire the island's brightly-colored fishermen's houses. Your tour then ends with the return boat ride to Venice. Rest of the evening free at leisure. Overnight at the Hotel

Day 6 / Venice - Milan

Breakfast at the Hotel. There will be a departure transfer to the train station to connect the train to Milan.(Standard Train Travel Included). Arrive and transfer to your Hotel by afternoon. Check into the Hotel. Rest of the afternoon you are free to explore Milan for shopping. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 7 / Milan

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today explore Milan Hop-on Hop-off Tour. There are three bus routes to choose from, with more than 30 combined stops between them, so you can find a stop close to where you are and where you want to go. The route for Line A, the red line, includes the Milan Duomo (Cathedral), the 14th-century Castello Sforzesco and the renowned La Scala opera house, one of the most famous theatres in the world. The entire loop of Line A takes 90 minutes. The route for Line B, the blue line, includes the skyscrapers of Palazzo Lombardia, the Porta Venezia (one of the historic city gates) and the Santa Maria delle Grazie church, in which Leonardo da Vinci's "The Last Supper" fresco can be seen. The route for Line C,the green line, includes the massive San Siro football (soccer) stadium, the Monumental Cemetery and a stop near the shopping quarter around Via Montenapoleone. With your hop-on hop-off ticket good for 24 hours. Explore Milan at your own pace, getting off the bus at any stop if you like to see an attraction or simply do some shopping. What's more, the three routes mentioned are connected, so it's no trouble at all to switch from one to the other in order to cover more ground in the whole city of Milan. Overnight at the Hotel

Day 8 / Milan - Nice

Breakfast at the Hotel. In the mid morning you will be transferred to Milan train station to connect your train to Nice. (Standard Class Train Ticket Included). Arrive in Nice and you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Check in Hotel. Rest of the day free to explore Nice on your own. Overnight at the Hotel





Day 9 / Nice

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today you will go on a Hop on Hop Off Bus Tour of Nice. Discover the attractions of Nice at your own pace with the ever-popular hop-on, hop-off tour. On this Hop-On-Hop-Off tour, you have the freedom to plan your own sightseeing itinerary. The stops cover all the major Nice attractions. The attractions covered in the tour are Massena Square, The Old Town, The church Notre Dame du Port, The citadel of Villefranche, La confiserie Florian, Museum of Natural History, Matisse museum. Roman Arena. La promenade du Paillon. Overnight at the Hotel

Day 10 / Nice - Paris

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today morning you will proceed for a Half Day Monaco and Eze Tour. See more of the French Riviera from a base in Nice with a half-day trip from Nice to Eze and Monaco. Explore two of the highlights along the Mediterranean, from the luxurious city-state of Monaco to the Medieval hilltop town of Eze. Tour a traditional perfumery in Eze, watch the changing of the guard at Monaco's Royal Palace and do a lap of Monaco's Formula One Grand Prix circuit. Later, you will return to Nice. Transfer to Nice Train Station to connect your train to Paris (Standard Class Train Ticket Included). Arrive in Paris and you will be transferred to your hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 11 / Paris (Hop on Hop Off with Eiffel Tower Level 2 and Cruise on Seine)

Breakfast at the Hotel. Explore your One day Hop-On Hop-Off bus ticket. Our first stop will be Eiffel Tower where we have to skip the line ticket to the 2nd floor. (Entrance Included). Then our next stop will be Champs-Elysees - The most beautiful avenue full with many shops and Arc de Triomphe. Next pass through the Musee d'Orsay- You can see the paintings of impressionist artists. Then next stop Arc de Triomphe. Arc de Triomphe is a monument commissioned by Napoleon for his glorious army when he returned covered in glory from the Austerlitz Battle. If you wish you can next visit Louvre Museum Louvre is the house of Mona Lisa. (Admission not included). Next is Cathedrale Notre-Dame de Paris - The amazing and splendid gothic cathedral in Paris. Next see Palais Garnier - Great Opera House. Then enjoy a One Hour Cruise on the Seine. (seine river cruise ride included). Next stop is Le Trocadero et son esplanade Trocadero is a palace built for the world's fair. The buildings now house a number of museums: the Musée national de la Marine (naval museum) and the Musée de l'Homme (ethnology) in the southern (Passy) wing. the Cité de l'Architecture et du Patrimoine, including the Musée national des Monuments Français, in the eastern (Paris) wing, from which one also enters the Théâtre national de Chaillot, a theatre below the esplanade. (Admission for Museums not included). Next stop will be Conciergerie - It is an old prison where the last king Louis XVI and Marie Antoinnette were held before the execution. (Admission not included). Your last stop is Pont des Arts - Bridge with love padlocks (Admission Ticket Included). There are many other stops you can visit on your hop on hop off tour. After spending time visiting different parts of the city, take a break from the busy streets and relax on a leisurely cruise along the Seine. With cruises running at all hours of the day, you can experience the cruise under the midday sun, catching the sites as the sun disappears over the horizon or wait until after dark to see the monuments twinkling against the night sky. Regardless of the hour, it is sure to be an experience to remember. Plus, the live commentary will divulge interesting facts about the history of the monuments that attract millions of tourists to Paris each year. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 12 / Paris

Breakfast at the Hotel. Day free to explore Paris Attractions on your own or wish to shop in the fashionable city. Alternatively you can visit Disneyland Paris for a day. (Contact our reservations team). Day is free as you wish. Overnight at the Hotel.





Day 13 / Paris

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the hotel by 1100 hrs. Day free at leisure on your own until departure transfer to the airport/train station.
