# Day 1 / Paris

Meet and greet upon arrival and transfer to the Hotel. Check into the Hotel. Rest of the day is free for you to discover Paris on your own, maybe visit the museums or Eiffel Tower or many other important sights in Paris. Overnight at the Hotel.





# Day 2 / Paris (Hop on Hop Off with Eiffel Tower Level 2 and Cruise on Seine)

Breakfast at the Hotel. Explore your One day Hop-On Hop-Off bus ticket. Our first stop will be Eiffel Tower where we have to skip the line ticket to the 2nd floor. (Entrance Included). Then our next stop will be Champs-Elysees - The most beautiful avenue full with many shops and Arc de Triomphe. Next pass through the Musee d'Orsay- You can see the paintings of impressionist artists. Then next stop Arc de Triomphe. Arc de Triomphe is a monument commissioned by Napoleon for his glorious army when he returned covered in glory from the Austerlitz Battle. If you wish you can next visit Louvre Museum - Louvre is the house of Mona Lisa. (Admission not included). Next is Cathedrale Notre-Dame de Paris - The amazing and splendid gothic cathedral in Paris. Next see Palais Garnier - Great Opera House. Then enjoy a One Hour Cruise on the Seine. (seine river cruise ride included). Next stop is Le Trocadero et son esplanade Trocadero is a palace built for the world's fair. The buildings now house a number of museums: the Musée national de la Marine (naval museum) and the Musée de l'Homme (ethnology) in the southern (Passy) wing. the Cité de l'Architecture et du Patrimoine, including the Musée national des Monuments Français, in the eastern (Paris) wing, from which one also enters the Théâtre national de Chaillot, a theatre below the esplanade. (Admission for Museums not included). Next stop will be Conciergerie - It is an old prison where the last king Louis XVI and Marie Antoinnette were held before the execution. (Admission not included). Your last stop is Pont des Arts - Bridge with love padlocks (Admission Ticket Included). There are many other stops you can visit on your hop on hop off tour. After spending time visiting different parts of the city, take a break from the busy streets and relax on a leisurely cruise along the Seine. With cruises running at all hours of the day, you can experience the cruise under the midday sun, catching the sites as the sun disappears over the horizon or wait until after dark to see the monuments twinkling against the night sky. Regardless of the hour, it is sure to be an experience to remember. Plus, the live commentary will divulge interesting facts about the history of the monuments that attract millions of tourists to Paris each year. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 3 / Paris - Brussels

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the Hotel. Departure transfer to Paris Train station to connect to your train to Brussels (Standard Class Train Ticket Included). Meet and transfer to your Hotel. Check into the Hotel. Later make your own way to the starting point of the tour. Discover all the things to do in Brussels from the top deck of an open top bus on your Brussels Hop On Hop Off Tour. This tour has 13 Hop on Hop off stops conveniently located around the City. You can travel to points of interest and the City's attractions at your leisure. Brussels is home to the European Union with the European Parliament, Manneken Pis, Cinquantenaire Arch, Art Nouveau and Victor Horta, the Grand-Place and the Atomium. The city abounds in architectural monuments, from the Renaissance, to modern times. Make your own way back to your Hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

### Day 4 / Brussels - Amsterdam

Breakfast at the Hotel. Departure transfer to the Brussels Train Station to connect to Amsterdam. (Standard Class Train Ticket Included). Meet upon arrival and transfer to your Hotel. Check into the Hotel.. The rest of the day is free to explore Amsterdam on your own. Overnight at the Hotel

#### Day 5 / Amsterdam

Breakfast at the Hotel. Proceed on your own to Central Station where your tour will start. One day hop-on hop-off bus tour, including a hop-on hop-off tour by boat. There are 11 bus stops around town. Board your open-top, double-decker bus at Central Station and explore Amsterdam at your own pace. You can remain on the bus for the entire 2-hour loop. From the open-top double-decker bus, you pass by the Anne Frank House, National Maritime Museum, Heineken Experience and





eclectic neighbourhoods like Jordaan and the historical Red Light District. More attractions like Van Gogh Museum, Rijksmuseum, Icebar, Madame Tussauds where you can disembark to explore. Then enjoy your I hour Canal Cruise. Leave the crowded tourist boats behind and explore Amsterdam's hidden corners in a luxury semi-open boat. Cruise the narrow canals of the city centre, and pass the Anne Frank House, the trendy 9 Streets area, the flower market and more. Ride in comfort and luxury in all types of weather, with a knowledgeable skipper and heated seats. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 6 / Amsterdam - Frankfurt

Breakfast at the hotel, Check out of Hotel. Departure Transfer to Amsterdam Train Station to connect your train to Frankfurt. (Standard Class Train Ticket Included). Arrive in Frankfurt and arrive at your hotel. Check in Hotel. Rest of the day free at leisure to explore Frankfurt on your own. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 7 / Frankfurt - Vienna

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today morning, explore your Frankfurt Hop-on Hop-off Sightseeing Tour. Get a feel for the might of the German economy in Frankfurt, the country's shiny financial capital. With your hop on hop off ticket see the best of the city aboard an open-top, double-decker bus. Hop on the bus at any of the 14 stops and enjoy the flexibility of choosing your own schedule and tour duration, as well as a narrated audio tour (available in 12 languages). Get a feel for Frankfurt as you pass top attractions like Römer (city hall), Paul's Church, the Botanical Garden Palmengarten and the Old Opera. Explore the waters that surround the city as you check out the docks on Main River, disembarking for a relaxing riverside stroll. With stops near museums, churches, green spaces and fun shopping districts, this tour offers something for everyone. In the afternoon departure Transfer to Frankfurt Train Station to connect your train to Vienna (Standard Class Train Ticket Included). Meet and greet upon arrival in Vienna and transfer to your hotel. Check in Hotel. Rest of the day free at leisure. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 8 / Vienna – Salzburg

Breakfast at the Hotel. In the morning proceed for City Tour & Schonbrunn sightseeing tour which starts at the Operngasse 8 and takes you to the Ringstrasse boulevard, where you pass many popular tourist attractions. First take a look at the impressive Vienna State Opera. It is home of the famous "Opera Ball" which takes place every year. Not far from the Opera, the grand Hofburg Palace is located, the former winter residence of the imperial family. Next you will see the monumental buildings of the Museum of Art History and the Museum of Natural History. Further sights on our tour are the neoclassical Parliament, the acclaimed Burgtheater and the striking City Hall. Later we will proceed for a Guided tour of Schloss Schönbrunn. On arrival at Schönbrunn Palace our guided tour starts at once, no need to wait for Austria's most popular tourist attraction! The former imperial summer residence is a listed World Heritage Site and attracts millions of people from all over the world every year. We visit the historic state-rooms and see how the imperial family once lived. You will also have time to take a stroll through the palace gardens or enjoy a cup of original Viennese coffee and a piece of delicious apple strudel. Our city tour ends at the Vienna State Opera. Later return to your Hotel. In the afternoon, departure transfer to Vienna train station to connect to your train to Salzburg (Standard train travel Included). Meet upon arrival in Salzburg and transfer to your Hotel. Check in Hotel. Rest of the day is free at leisure. Overnight at the Hotel.

### Day 9 / Salzburg - Innsbruck

Breakfast at the Hotel. In the morning you will go on a The Original Sound of Music Tour.(SIC Basis). You will have to make your own way to the starting point of this tour at Mirabellplatz, directly in front of St. Andrä Church. Your guide will not only take you to the original locations of the film, where you will receive interesting information about the filming of The Sound





of Music , but also offers you the opportunity to get to know the historic city of Salzburg and the enchanting landscape of the Salzkammergut better learn. The tour is conducted in English. Relive your favourite scenes from the classic musical "The Sound of Music" on this Salzburg sightseeing tour. Visit filming sites around the city while your guide provides historical background on Salzburg's top attractions and architectural jewels, including the gazebo where "Sixteen Going on Seventeen" was shot. "The Sound of Music" filming locations tour in Salzburg In the afternoon departure transfer to the train station to connect your train to Innsbruck (Standard Train Travel Included). Arrive in Innsbruck and transfer to your Hotel. Check into the Hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

# Day 10 / Innsbruck

Breakfast at the Hotel. Proceed on 1 Day Hop on Hop Off Innsbruck Tour. Enjoy being chauffeured to the main sights and attractions! The Sightseer is a hop-on hop-off bus that gives you a great feel for your holiday destination. The bus also takes you to stops outside of the city centre so you save yourself a walk. The route passes, for example, the Bergisel Ski Jump and the Tirol Panorama Museum with its famous Giant Panoramic Painting, as well as Ambras Castle. The Sightseer also goes through the district of Pradl and past the lovely Gründerzeit villas in Saggen. The journey also takes you past the River Inn and the Imperial Gardens, as well as to the most important museums in and around the city centre. The ticket is also valid for IVB buses and trams in the centre of Innsbruck. Overnight at the Hotel.

### Day 11 / Innsbruck – Interlaken

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Innsbruck Train Station to connect your train to Interlaken. (Standard Class Train Ticket Included). Arrive at Interlaken Station and you will meet and transfer to your hotel. Arrive at your Hotel and check into the Hotel. Rest of the day is free at leisure to explore beautiful Interlaken. Overnight at the Hotel.

# Day 12 / Interlaken – Jungfrau – Top of Europe

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today make your way to the starting point of the Interlaken train station to visit Jungfraujoch - Top of Europe is the highlight of any Swiss holiday. The highest railway station in Europe is located 3,454 metres above sea level. A scenic cogwheel train for the most interesting mountain train trip via Kleine Scheidegg at the foot of the famous Eiger North Face to Jungfraujoch, Europe's highest railway station. Enjoy the incredible world of eternal snow and ice. Visit the Ice Palace, experience the breathtaking panorama view from the Sphinx Observation Terrace overlooking the Aletsch Glacier (Europe's longest glacier) and the snow-capped peaks of the neighbouring countries. The downhill mountain trip takes us to Interlaken. Overnight at the Hotel.

#### Day 13 / Interlaken - Lucerne

Breakfast at the Hotel. You are free in the morning to enjoy this beautiful paradise on earth. Later, check out of the Hotel and transfer to Interlaken train station to connect the train to Lucerne (Standard Class Train Ticket Included). Arrive and transfer to your hotel and check into the Hotel. Rest of the day is free to explore Lucerne or shop. Overnight at the Hotel.

### Day 14 / Lucerne - Mount Titlis

Breakfast at the Hotel. Proceed on your own to the Lucerne Tourist Office where you will board your coach for your Mt Titlis Tour. Enjoy your comfortable, climate-controlled coach and relish scenic Swiss vistas as you travel along to Engelberg, a mountain resort cradled by the Swiss Alps. Climb aboard a Rotair. a rotating cable car that affords panoramic Alpine vistas,





and ascends to a dizzying height of 10,623 feet (3, 238 metres). Take in 360-degree views and then disembark at Mt. Titlis' snowy summit. Enjoy some free time to visit the magical Ice Palace and ride the Ice Flyer, if the weather allows, in order to get closer to frozen crevices. Soar down a snow slide in Glacier Park and summon your courage to walk over Europe's highest suspension bridge, the Titlis Cliff Walk. Warm up with a steaming beverage (own expense) and then reconvene with your guide for the return journey to Lucerne. Overnight at the Hotel.

### Day 15 / Lucerne – Zurich

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the Hotel and you will be transferred to Lucerne train station to connect your train to Zurich. (Standard Class Ticket Included). Arrive and you will be transferred to your hotel. Check into the Hotel or if the room is not ready please leave baggage at reception. Make your way to the starting point of the tour at the centrally located Sihlquai Bus Terminal in Zurich. Explore Zurich City Tour. Cruise on your coach past popular attractions like the sophisticated shopping district of Bahnhofstrasse, a place considered one of the world's best shopping areas, and the architecturally rich university district. Admire from the outside the Church of Our Lady (Fraumunster); enjoy the pretty buildings of Limmatquai; and admire the exterior of some of the world's finest museums. Capture photographs of the charming Old Town as you travel towards opulent hillside villas backed by the sky-piercing summits of the Alpine mountains. Enjoy a moment of tranquillity beside the glittering Lake Zurich and then return to your original departure point, where the tour concludes. Overnight at the Hotel

### Day 16 / Zurich

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check out of the hotel by 1100 hrs. Day free at leisure on your own until departure transfer to the airport/train station.
